### I. Flexibility

# p. 42 #16 Tongue and slur.

Observe marked fingerings. Rest as needed. Play slowly and smoothly.

#### II. Chromatic scales

p. 78 #6

Slight breath accents on each beat to ensure good rhythm.

### III. Major scales

## p. 63 #23-25 Key of Bb (concert Ab)

Observe dynamics and articulation. Play slowly at first. Use metronome and try to increase speed daily. Note your tempos in the margin for future reference.

#### IV. Scale studies

p. 20 #41-45

Scale patterns and velocity. Try to read through once daily for accuracy.

# V. Dotted 8<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> note rhythms

p. 26-27 #15-16

Slight separation between the dotted  $8^{th}$  and  $16^{th}$  note. Play the  $16^{th}$  note like a  $32^{nd}$  note.

## VI. Songs & duets

p. 201-202 #41-44

Some grace notes. Read about grace notes in Arban p. 88-89.

p. 254 #20-22

Three duets in minor. Name the keys.
